School's Out Italian Pasta Potluck: Friday, June 15th 6:30pm

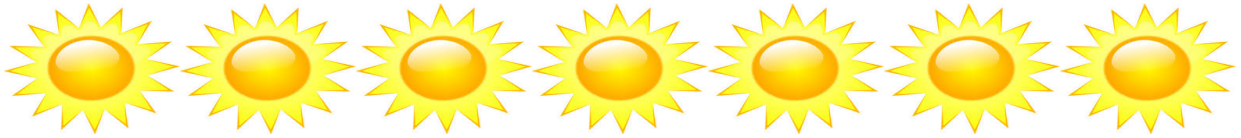
